CONTROL OF DEAFNESS (NPPCD)

The Programme was initiated in year 2007 by Govt. of India. However in J&K it was implemented in Jammu district of Jammu Division in 2015-16.

In FY 2021-22, it has been approved for 6 new Districts viz Samba, Udhampur, Poonch, Ramban, Kishtwar and Reasi.

Funds have been approved for Procurement of Equipment at District Hospitals and Trainings, as well as for IEC at State level.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

- To prevent avoidable hearing loss on account of disease or injury.
- Early identification, diagnosis and treatment of ear problems responsible for hearing loss and deafness.
- To medically rehabilitate persons of all age groups, suffering with deafness.
- To strengthen the existing inter-sectoral linkages for continuity of the rehabilitation programme, for persons with deafness.
- To develop institutional capacity for ear care services by providing support for equipment, material and training personnel.

At the District level, following contractual posts have been approved:

- 1. ENT Surgeon (in case ENT Consultant from regular side is not available) (only for Jammu)
- 2. Audiologist (Audiologist & Speech language Pathologist approved for only District Jammu): Vacant
- 3. Audiometric Assistant (approved for only District Jammu): Vacant

All posts are vacant at present. ENT Surgeon from regular side is conducting programme activities.

ACHIEVEMENT

- Equipment procured in all District Hospitals
- Audiometry rooms established in 8 DHs (Poonch pending, Samba ongoing)
- Audiometry training of available staff ongoing in GMCs
