National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme (NVBDCP)

FACILITY PROVIDED TO THE PEOPLE

> Malaria:

Malaria diagnostic facility and radical treatment is available free of cost in all Govt. Health Institutions of Jammu Province.

- Active Surveillance: Preparation of blood smears from suspected fever cases for malaria by Field staff like Basic Health Workers during their house to house visits in rural & far flung areas and their examination from nearest PHC by Laboratory Technician and to provide Free Medication to the patient (in case screened positive for malaria).
- Passive Surveillance: Facility for screening fever cases for Malaria is available at all CHCs/PHCs & District Hospitals with a provision of Free Anti Malaria Medication for patients with Malaria.

> Dengue:

Sentinel Surveillance Hospitals have been established and kept functional to provide diagnostic facility to the general masses for Dengue. Name of Functional Sentinel Surveillance Hospitals in Jammu Division:

- Thermal fogging operations in urban areas in collaboration with local Municipal Authorities.
